

Member Benefits Plugin Documentation

Installation

1. Upload the member-benefits folder to the /wp-content/plugins/ directory.
2. Activate the plugin through the 'Plugins' menu in WordPress.
3. Use the [member_benefits] shortcode in any post or page to display the member benefits.

File Structure

The plugin contains the following files:

- member-benefits.php: The main plugin file.
- assets/style.css: The stylesheet for the plugin.
- assets/tabs.js: The JavaScript file for handling tab functionality.

Editing HTML

To edit the HTML output of the plugin, modify the `member_benefits_display` function in `member-benefits.php`.

Editing JavaScript

To edit the JavaScript functionality for the plugin, modify the `tabs.js` file located in the `member-benefits/assets` plugin folder.
